The safest and most environmentally friendly way to manage released natural gas is through controlled burning, known as flaring.

Flaring creates a tall flame along with a blow torch or jet engine sound. These should only be present when crews are on-site up to 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There may also be a gas odorant smell, like rotten eggs, which could linger for a few days after our work is done.

When flaring takes place, we notify emergency officials and continuously monitor the flame.

If you see something suspicious, an explosion, or uncontrolled flame, call our Security Command Center at 800-760-3295. If there is an emergency, call 9-1-1 first, then us.
